- x Dr. Hedegard: City in response to some questions all children with IEP are eligible for a transition plan by the time they turn 16, to set graduation plan. We want to prepare for this earlier than age 16. Maximum graduation (certificate of completion) is age 22.
- x Dr. Hedegard: IEE is a parent right, but we want to look to expertise of IEP teams. SCUSD wants to know if there are issues with the district IEP teams.

Listening Session regarding School Reopening:

- x Special Education assessments should be available outside if services like sports and dining are available outside
- x Far too many kids in general education classrooms with insufficient services, so not progressing at grade level
