The Superintendent through the District Title IX Compliance Offsceril take appropriate actions to reinforce the District's sexual harassment policy.

<u>Prohibited sexual harassment includes, but is not limited to, sexual violence, unwelcome</u> sexual <u>advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, visual or physical conduct of a sexual nature made against another person of the same or opposite sex in the educational setting, under any of the following conditions: (Education Code 212.5; 5 CCR 4916)</u>

- 1. Submission to the conduct is explicitly or implicitly made a term or condition of an individual's academic status or progress.
- 2. Submission to or rection of the conduct by an individual is used as the basis for academic decisions affecting the individual.
- 3. The conduct has the purpose or effect of having a negative impact on the individual's academic performance, or of creating an intimidating tilleos of environment. Upon verifying that sexual harassment occurred, then ensure that appropriate action is promptly taken to end the harassment, askditts effects on the person subjected to the harassment, and prevent any further instances of the harassment. In addition, the student may file a formal complaint with the Superintendent or designistrict's Title IX Compliance

Officer in accordance whitthe district District's Uniform Ceomplaint Procedures.

The District's Title IX Compliance Officeshall maintain a record of all reported cases of sexual harassment to enable the trict to monitor, address, and prevent repetitive harassing behavior in District schools.

BP 5145.7 Students

The Governing Board is committed to maintaining a safe learning environment that is free of harassment discrimination. The Board prohibits school or at school prohibits, sexual harassment targeted at any student by any Thes Broard also prohibits retaliatory behavior or action against any person who submotismplaint or testifies about, or otherwise suppts a complainant in alleging sexual harassment.

The District strongly encourages any student who feels that they are being behaveexually harassed on school grounds or at a selpohsored or school lated activity by anothestudent or an adul, or who haveexperienced offcampussexual harassment/ofine/social mediactivity and/or sexual violencethat has a continuing effect on campus, to immediately contact the inchest, the principal, or any other available school employee. Any district employee who receives a report or observes an incident of sexual harassment shall notify the principalite Designated Title IX Administrator a District Title IX Compliance Gicer. Once notified, the Site Designated Title Axiministrator or District Title IX Compliance Gicer shall take the steps to promptly investigate and address the allegation, as specified in the accompanying administrative regulation and sitepersonnel shall take immediate steps to intervene when safe to do so when she or he witnesses an act of discrimination, harassment, intimidation, retaliation, and ullying. While the district has promulgated a written complaint form, there is no requir

harassment, shall be investigated and prompt action shall be taken to stop any harassment, prevent recurrence, and address any continuing effect on students

- 6. Information abouthe District's procedure for investigating complaints and the person(s) to whom a report of sexual harassment should be;made
- 7. Information about the rights of students and parents/guardians to file a civil or criminal complaint, as applicable, including the right to file a civil or criminal complaint while the District investigation of a sexual harassment complaint is ongaint
- 8. A clear message that, when needed, the District will take interim measures to ensure a safe school environment for audent who is the complainant or victim of sexual harassment and/or other students during an investigation and that, to the extent possible, when such interim measures are taken, they shall not disadvantage the complainant or victim of the alleged harassmen

The District Title IX Compliance Officer shall receive training and shall oversee appropriate trainings for District staff, including management as well as certificated and and staff. Each Site Designated Title IX Administrator shall receive initial training as appropriate to carry out their duties.
