An "occupational program" is one that prepares a student for employment or job advancement. Occupational programs can be of any length, from a 40-hour

program to a two-year program. The term "short

program" is used to describe a program that is less than two years in length.

Occupational programs are designed to provide students with the skills and knowledge necessary to enter a specific occupation.

These programs are often offered by community colleges and technical schools.

Occupational programs can be a great way for students to gain hands-on experience in their field of interest.

They can also provide students with a clear path to employment after graduation.
