I. Overview/History of Department or Program

NorthwestLandParkLLQ(NWLP)proposes to construct a residential/mixedusecommunityon approximately31.7acreswithin the LandParkCommunityPlanArea of the City of SacramentoThe development is located adjacent to Jededial Smith Elementary School and Arthur A. Benjamin Health Profession High School.

The District currently owns a vacanttwo and a half acreparcel of land adjoining the elementary schoolsite. The developer is interested in partnering with the District to develop the vacant parcel as Jededial Farms which would be built as a model for green technology, sustainability, recycling, and safety and partnerships with the public sector, the private sector and the local community. Jededial Farms would provide education to both students and the community in green technology, environmental protection, agriculture, health and nutrition.
